G3 US: 28739 & G7 US: 28740 Delivery

In 2020 Covid-19 forced NZ Mines Rescue to review of the delivery of the G3 US: 28739 & G7 28740 as border restrictions prevented NZ Mines Rescue's Australian tutor Peter Arthur from travelling to NZ to deliver the programme through classroom-based training courses.

To enable the programme to continue Peter Arthur moved to a distance-based delivery model that he developed and successfully trialled in conjunction with NZ Mines Rescue. To ensure no disruptions due to travel lockdowns between Australia and New Zealand the 2021 G3 and G7 Courses will be delivered by the same successful model.

The model will use ZOOM video conferencing as its key tool. Peter will begin each training day with a 1 hour ZOOM session. Participants will then focus on working on theory questions. A second short (30 mins) session will be held at 1pm before participants spending the afternoon developing the processes and plans that are part of the assessment. There will be another short ZOOM session at the end of day to review progress on the day's activities. Participants will email their day's work to Peter by 6pm and he will review it overnight. Participants will also be able to have individuals video sessions with Peter via one of the messaging apps to help them with any areas they have questions.

This model is focused on participants completing the programme and its assessment by the end of the week. Despite it being on-line participants need to commit the time to the course in the same way they would for face-to-face training. It is not designed for participants to attend the ZOOM sessions and complete activities and assessment to their own schedule at a later stage.

If there are multiple people from the same company participating, they may benefit from engaging with the course as a group rather than as individuals.

G3 Pre-Course Work

There is some Pre-course reading and a short assessment to refresh G3 participants knowledge of Risk Assessment prior to the course.
